As the seasons change we get excited for the next process in growing the grapes. Trimming began this past weekend. We are looking for a final four of the healthiest and most promising vines from each plant. We start with reducing the vines from each plant from 16-20 vines down to 4-7 vines. These will then be trimmed to four vines, two each for the bottom two wires of the trellis system. The winter cover of soil on the base of the each plant is also being removed to promote proper growth.
